Dear Healthcare Provider,

As a reminder, starting May 1, 2024, except for special circumstances to be considered on a case-by-case basis, COVID-19 immunizations will not be available until the fall 2024 influenza and COVID-19 immunization program. This is to minimize the impact of getting a late COVID-19 vaccine dose on a client's eligibility for a fall 2024 COVID-19 vaccine.

We would like to advise you that **the current COVID & Flu Order Survey is scheduled to close on April 30th at midnight.**

Between May 1st and the start of the 2024 fall campaign, health care providers can discuss with their clients to determine if they are considered high risk and would benefit from a COVID-19 vaccine dose prior to the fall immunization campaign (e.g., those who may have or are known to have reduced immune response to vaccination).

1. In order to obtain a dose of COVID-19 vaccine, clients should receive a recommendation from their primary care provider or clinical specialist (i.e. CCMB).
2. Manitoba continues to recommend at least 6 months between COVID-19 vaccine doses for the optimal immune response, however, a minimum of 3 months is required.
